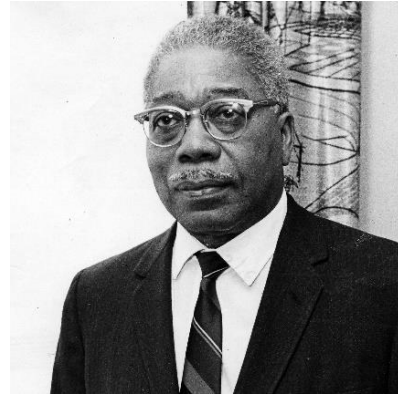




Belleville Wix Academy
